

Route to The Place Theatre, Bedford

(Approaching Bedford from the East) (A421, from A1 North/Cambridge)

(From the A1, join the A421 at the Black Cat roundabout, signposted for Bedford and Milton Keynes.)

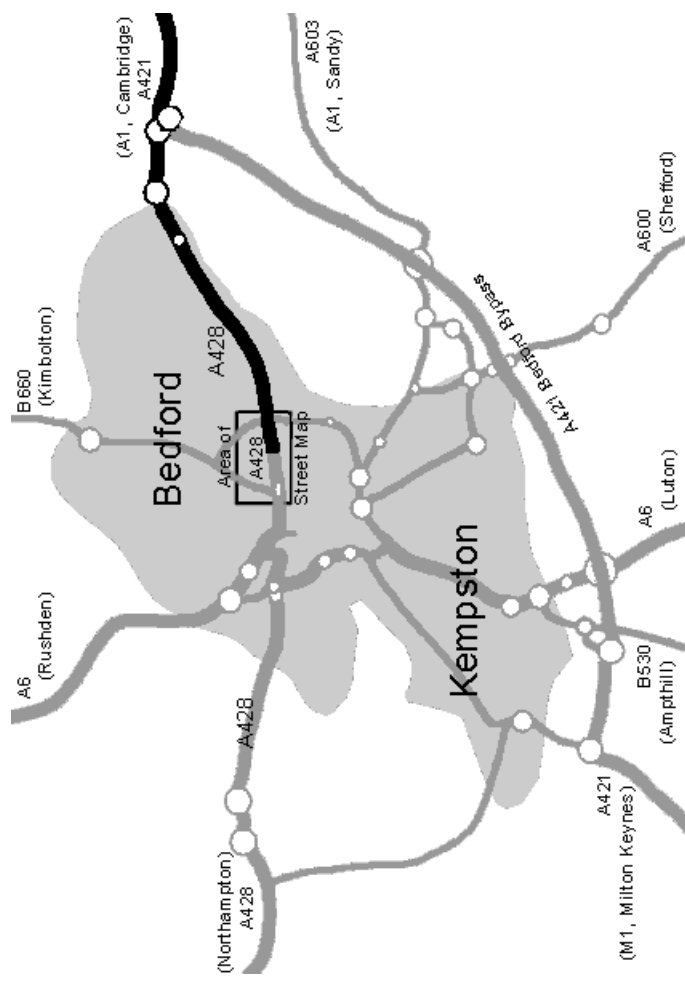
After about 4 miles, leave the A421 via a slip-road signposted 'Bedford, A428'. Turn right at the roundabout at the top of the slip-road, and then immediately bear left at the next roundabout, following the signs for Bedford.

At the next roundabout (adjacent to MFI), go straight ahead onto a short section of dual carriageway, then straight ahead at the next roundabout, following signs for the A428 throughout.

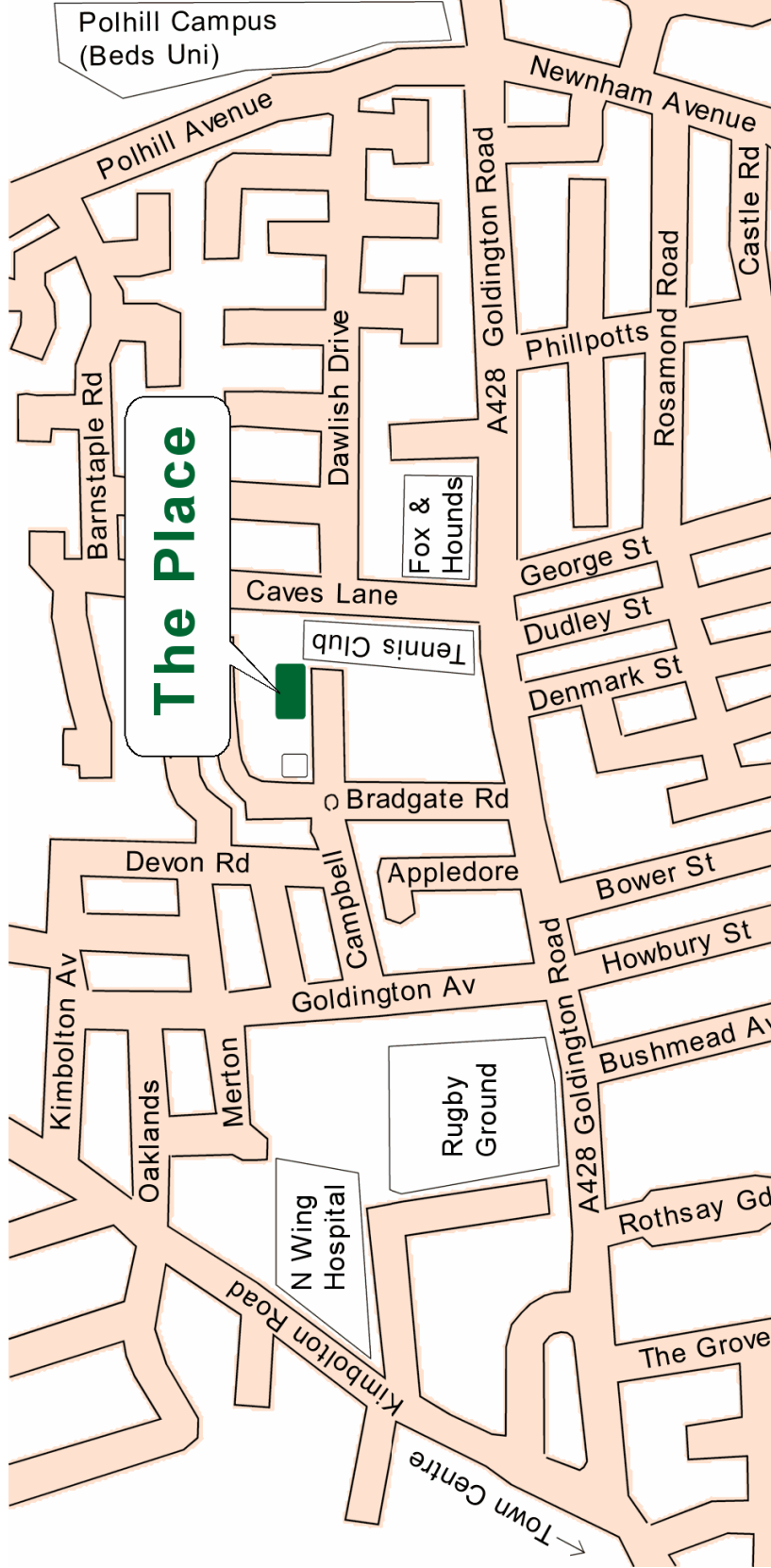
After about a mile, a cross-roads with traffic lights will be reached, with the Bedfordshire University Polhill Campus on the right: You are now on the right-hand edge of the Street Map shown below.

Go straight ahead at the lights, following signs for 'Town Centre, A428'. Continue down the road, looking for the 'Fox and Hounds' public house on the right. Ignore the road immediately after the pub, but continue a further 200 yards, and then turn **right** into Bradgate Road.

Continue to the top of Bradgate Road, and turn **right** at the mini-roundabout to pass in front of the green building (the Badminton Club): The Place is immediately ahead of you, with the car park entrance immediately before the building. An overflow car park may be open on the right.



The PLACE Bedford



The Place can be found at the top of Bradgate Road, Bedford (off Goldington Road, the main A428 Northampton to A1/Cambridge road).

Turn off Goldington Road into Bradgate Road (look for a brown 'theatre' sign here, not very easy to spot), and follow the road to the top. At the mini roundabout, turn **right**, leaving the large green corrugated iron building (the badminton club) on your left, and continue a further 60 metres: The Place is on the left, with the main car park entrance on the left immediately before the building. An additional car park may also be available opposite the building, on your right.
